2017


- Nomination forms for Glasgow (European Cup) to be emailed to all those on the Southern Cross email list and posted on the website by Oct 10th.

REVIEW

Now in the 6th year of its reincarnation and 3rd year of existing as an incorporated body, Southern Cross Masters Hockey continues to grow to provide a means whereby its members can enjoy the benefits of prolonging playing or otherwise be involved in the game of hockey at the International level at ages beyond 60 years.

Our committee structure is now well established with all members being involved both in their particular "portfolios" as well as in the general running of the association. In particular, now with a well organised secretariat we can expect further initiatives and efficiencies in our operation which should be to the benefit of our members in future years.

The committee meets at least twice a year to formalise the implementation of the wishes of the members as determined at the Annual General Meeting, and to carry out such other duties as are required for the running of the Association.

This year all the 7 positions on the committee are open for re-election as are the appointed positions for reappointment.

The last 12 month period has been a very busy one for SCMH. We have been involved in sending 3 teams to London for the 2015 WGMA European Cup Tournament Trophy, two teams to Kuala Lumpur for the 2015 PacRim Tournament and 6 teams to Newcastle for the WGMA World Cup Tournament Trophy competition. These competitions have been enjoyed by more than 200 Southern Cross members with many of us attending more than one of them.

We look forward to perhaps a less hectic but equally beneficial next 24 months or so with 4 Southern Cross teams entered for the WGMA European Cup Tournament Trophy in Glasgow next year and an expected large involvement in the WGMA World Cup to be held in Barcelona in June 2018.

PacRim Tournament Oct/November 2015

SCMH sent two 60+ teams to compete in this WGMA sanctioned competition, held in Kuala Lumpur from 26th October – 1st November 2015 in conjunction with the 3rd Asian Cup. Reports are that everyone had a great time enjoying the particular Malaysian weather conditions, style of entertainment and organisation. Although not particularly successful on the field, eg. having to compete against virtually the England 60s team, the teams played some good hockey under the leadership of Kevin Redden and Dudley Evans (Blue team) and Jeff Wait and Trevor Dancer (Red team), with both teams finishing out of the medals.

Thank you team manager Bruce (VB) Smith and *Chef de Mission*/Team Manager Len Collier for all your great work to make the trip happen and get the teams on the field. I would also like to acknowledge the inclusion of several of our Southern Cross colleagues from across the Tasman who participated for SCMH for the first time.

May: 8th WGMA World Cup Tournament Trophy Competition Newcastle, 3rd - 12th May 2016

With 6 teams entered in the Tournament Trophy competition at this years World Cup in Newcastle, Southern Cross had the largest single contingent of any group with over 150 members in the group.

Our teams gathered in Newcastle a few days before the start of the tournament on Friday 29th April at our

hotel The Executive Inn, located within easy walking distance of the Newcastle International Hockey Centre. After a few days of training and local sight seeing the teams got down to the serious stuff of playing hockey. With only short intermissions for watching International Rugby League and attending various Tournament and associated dinners and other functions, the hockey continued into week two and eventually a pretty successful final series.

Congratulations to all players, you looked great at the opening ceremony in your colourful polo shirts, and to officials and supporters for your performances both on and off the field. The teams all acquitted themselves well with Southern Cross winning two of the age divisions. For the third time SCMH won the 70+ Gold at this level and for the first time, the 65+ Gold. Hopefully we can do as well in Barcelona in 2017.



In 2018 SCMH will be sending as many teams as we are allowed, to the 9th WGMA World Cup to be held in Barcelona in June. More details to follow when available.
